Junior Registration Day

As you will see from the other pages of this newsletter, our Junior Registration Day is being held with a sausage sizzle/barbecue at our Ormond Park pavilion on Sunday, August 27.

Training starts a week later. Our Under 16s and Under 10s train on Tuesday afternoons, the Under 14s on Thursday afternoons, the Under 12s on Wednesday afternoons and the girls at this stage on Wednesdays. The cricket season starts on October 7, the week after school resumes.

Training will continue through the school holidays, and we would hope that any players who go away would do some training and skills by themselves or with Mum and Dad, or brothers, sisters and friends.

You will also see attached a form seeking family information for our Moonee Valley club. We urge you to fill out the form and bring it along to the registration day.

We <u>don't</u> need a North West Cricket Association registration form for players who were registered at Moonee Valley last season. We will have forms available for new players.

At this stage Moonee Valley is looking to field this season:

- One Under 16 team.
- One Under 17 Girls' team.
- Three Under 14 teams one to play home games at Ormond Park on Sundays.
- One Under 14 girls' team.
- Four Under 12 teams one to play home games at Ormond Park on Sundays.
- Three Under 10 teams.

HEHRANEGRANDEURICANAS

A decision has been made for 2006/07 to institute competitive selection for the highest-graded team in Under 12 and Under 14.

This will enable players to aim for Shield or B Grade selection, based on their development and progress.

Our other teams in each age group will continue to be formulated on the basis of school or friendship groups — as has been our policy across all teams prior to this season.

As a Club we depend a lot on our junior Coaches/Team Managers each week. There are a lot of tasks other Mums and Dads can carry out to contribute to the running of our junior teams and our Club. It will help us continue to provide an enjoyable cricket experience for our children.

JUNIOR REGISTRATION FEES

Our junior registration fees have been set at last season's fee - \$110. This represents excellent value. Our players are also required to be members of our parent body, the Moonee Valley Sporting Club.

Sporting Club fees are \$25 for juniors and \$60 for families – which includes parents and all children.

The Moonee Valley Sporting Club constitution requires any person who uses Club facilities more than twice to be a MVSC member, so we urge all families to consider this and sign up.

Cricketers who play football at Moonee Valley will already be Sporting Club members, and so this component of their fees will have already been paid.



PARENT ROSTER FOR JUNIOR CRICKET

Volunteer clubs depend heavily on the support of families to help carry out a range of tasks each year, and Moonee Valley Cricket Club is no exception.



We ask each of our families to provide a parent to help out at least twice during the season, and would obviously seek to ensure that they are helping out at the game where their child/children are playing. We will be drawing up a roster for all parents to ensure that the jobs are covered.

You might think that you are not suited to some of the tasks because of a limited knowledge of cricket – such as scoring – but the Club is happy to provide basic tuition to enable you to carry out the job.

Our junior coaches and team managers need this support by fellow parents to help them do their job effectively.

Jobs for which we need volunteers are:

- *Junior canteen duty (for parents with teams playing at Ormond Park). Job: 9am midday.
- *Cleaning/tidying club rooms (for Friday night teams U/10 & U/14 Girls)
- *Scoring (for your son's or daughter's team).
- *Umpiring (if you're not confident, this can be just square-leg).
- *Looking after the Club kit/drinks/sunscreen for your child's team.
- *Setting up the roll-out synthetic pitch (for Under 12s at Ormond Park) and bringing it in.
- *Setting up the roll-out synthetic pitch (for Friday evening U/10s or U/14 Girls at Ormond Park) and bringing it in.
- *Cooking on the BBQ at a club official function.
- *Providing a large salad at the Junior Presentation Night.
- *Helping with drills at training.
- *Saturday afternoon canteen duty (Seniors playing at Ormond Park).
- *Setting out boundary, checking pitch markings/sweep pitch for your child's game.
- *Scoring for one of the senior teams.
- *Transport (for away games).
- *Transport (Under 10 coaches).
- *Putting up portable shade marquees.
